



Group Name and Purpose of Meeting /Meeting date, start time, location

ROLL CALL

READING AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

REPORTS OF OFFICERS

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES

STANDARD ORDER OF BUSINESS

- Unfinished Business

- New Business

For each item of business, indicate:

Title or topic, Short description, Person responsible

ANNOUNCEMENTS

ADJOURNMENT





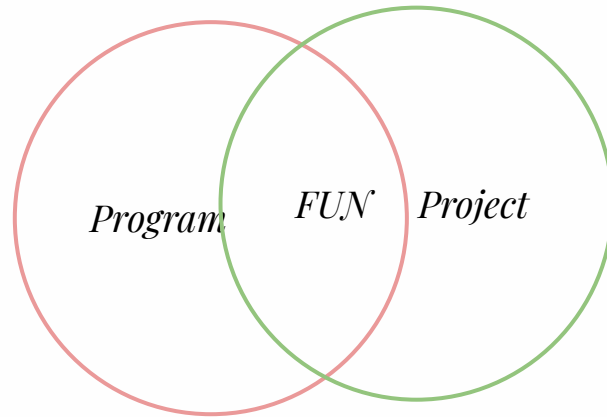
